Bring: Work gloves and, if you have them, a weeder, spade and shovel. Plus your own snacks and a filled reusable water bottle (and help say NO to more plastic).

You'll Get: Expert instruction on how to identify and get rid of invasive plants and tree-strangling vines, lots of satisfaction, and a "I Love My Park Day" T-shirt.
